




What is I/I? Inflow and Infiltration



Some Sources of I/I



Inflow is clear water that quickly enters the wastewater system after rainfall events from sources such as sewer cleanouts, sump pumps, gutters, building foundation drains, and broken maintenance hole covers.



Infiltration is clear water that gradually enters the wastewater system below ground through cracks and openings in sewer service lines and joints, and public sewer mains and deteriorated maintenance holes.

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

Consequences of Excessive I/I

- Low customer satisfaction
- Costs greater than needed
- Potential health risks
- Property damage
- Regulatory actions










I/I in Wanamingo

- Wet weather flows are <u>8 times</u> higher than regular dry weather flows
- Leading to increases cost of future sewer charges for Regional Wastewater Treatment System





Why Are We Doing This Program?

- Sump pump programs are typically the MOST cost-effective method to reduce I/I in the system.
- Removing I/I from the sanitary sewer has several benefits:
 - Saves Money: Reduces sewer charges from future Regional Treatment System.
 - It's the Neighborly Thing to Do: Lowers the risk of backups & property damage
 - Supports Future Growth: Freeing up capacity in the system enables future development.








Why a Sump Pump Program?

- A few sump pumps can make a big difference
 - Typical sump pump 20-100 gpm a piece
 - Typical 8" sewer capacity 350 gpm
 - As few as FOUR pumps can take up the pipe capacity and cause a backup in the neighborhood.

Key Aspects to Ordinance Revision

- Section 53 of Wanamingo Code of Ordinances prohibited clear water connections before Amendment
- Key Aspects:
 - City, City's representative, or *private plumber inspects*
 - Sump pumps, beaver drains, footing drains, defective laterals, etc. are prohibited from discharging to sanitary sewer
 - Rigid discharge piping, no valves or flex hose
 - Sump pits must have pumps
 - 30 days to inspect, 90 days to correct deficiencies
 - City can issue \$100/month surcharge for violations or no inspection


The Inspection

- Notice of Violation and instructional diagrams given, if needed



Water Service Material Inventory


- Inventory mandates water services by revised Lead and Copper Rule by the EPA.
- Water Service line connects your homes system to the water main (typically in the street).
- Property owners with lead or galvanized services will be notified.






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Installation Examples: Sump Pumps




Installation Examples: Sump Pumps


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Installation Examples: Beaver Drain/Tile


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
